



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: students of ARCHAEOLOGY

The Department of Archaeology of the University of Hradec Králové, Czech Republic, offers this unique opportunity to take part in the FIELD EXCAVATION in the region of EASTERN BOHEMIA, an area that was densely inhabited since prehistory!

The main activity will be the participation in the rescue excavation in advance of construction of the highway from Hradec Králové to Jičín. This excavation will take place on 7,5 km long corridor Sadová – Plotiště and run for one year. We expect various archaeological situations spanning from Neolithic settlements to mass graves of Battle of Königgrätz that took place during the Prussian-Austrian War in 1866. The excavation offers a wide range of archaeological features and is acquainted with the Czech methodology used on such a type of excavation. Additionally, the students attend other small-scale excavations of the Department: e.g. excavation of rectangular enclosure from the Late Iron Age in Markvartice, or excavation of occupation of abris in Bohemian Paradise. All the archaeological sites are within the territory of Eastern Bohemia.

WHO CAN APPLY?

This ERASMUS traineeship is intended only for students of ARCHAEOLOGY (BA, MA or Ph.D.) via ERASMUS PROGRAMME.
